

This model is treated with DreamLine's exclusive ClearMax™ Glass technology. This is a specially formulated coating that prevents the build up of soap and water spots.

Install the surface with the ClearMax™ label towards the inside of the shower. Please note that depending on the model, the glass may be coated on either one or both surfaces.

For best results, squeegee the glass after each use and dry with a soft cloth.



- All drawings in this installation manual are for illustrative purposes only and are not drawn to scale.

TEMPERED GLASS WARNING

- Your Shower Door Glass Could Shatter Without Warning if Improperly Installed or Mishandled
- Do Not install or operate a shower door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered edges or
 is otherwise damaged and/or has been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as
 tile, marble or glass.
- The main causes of tempered glass breakage are:
 - o Improper handling, storage or installation
 - Misuse/abuse
 - Lack of maintenance
 - Failure to replace damaged glass
 - Improper handling during storage, unpacking and installation:
- Corners and edges are the most susceptible area to damage on a lite of tempered glass and should be protected and handled with care during storage, unpacking, installation and operation. A concentrated point of pressure or impact with a surface harder than itself may cause the tempered glass to shatter. The tempered glass may release immediately, within several hours or even days later.
- o Incorrect installation of door hardware, rollers, hinges, channels, stopper or glass:
- Improper installation may include: loose hardware and/or lack of proper gaskets between the hardware and glass. Additionally, improper alignment of guide rails, wall profiles or other hardware during installation or operation may place stress on the glass edges and cause it to break.
- This product must be installed by a professional and experienced installer familiar with the safe handling of tempered glass.
- Improper use of this product:
 - Aggressively opening or closing the door may cause trauma to the glass, which can lead to breakage. This may occur immediately or hours or even days later.
 - The shower door hardware and glass should be inspected periodically:
 - Instruct the homeowner how to perform a periodic inspection of the shower hardware and glass - some minor adjustments may be necessary based upon the use (or misuse) of the shower door. Ensure that the hardware remains tight and that the door alignment and operation are correct. Any adjustments should be made upon discovery to prevent damage to the product.
 - Additional considerations should be given to the installation of frameless tempered glass products in households with young children or an elderly person due to an increased chance of improper handling. In such cases, alternatives such as shower curtains or grab bars should be considered.

GENERAL PREPARATION

- After opening all boxes and packages, read this introduction carefully. Check that all the
 items are included in the package by marking off the components on the "Detailed
 Diagram of Product Components" page. Examine all boxes and packages for shipping
 damage. If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or is missing parts; please
 contact our Customer Support department within 3 business days of the delivery date.
 Please note that DreamLine® will not replace any damaged products or missing
 parts free of charge after 3 business days or if the product has been installed. Please
 contact DreamLine® if you have any questions.
- Please note that you should refer to your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine® is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.
- If this unit is going to be installed in a new construction, install all the required plumbing
 and drainage before installing the shower. Use a competent and licensed (if required
 by local code) plumber for all plumbing installation.
- Make sure that prior to beginning the installation, the surfaces are leveled and solid and
 will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right
 angles. Irregular installation surface level, radius corners or improper angle of side walls
 will result in serious problems for your installation. Please note that some adjustments
 and drilling will be necessary during the installation process.
- Protect all primary surfaces of the product during installation. Never set your glass down
 directly onto a tile floor. Leave corner protectors in place until it is necessary to remove
 them. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard to protect the bottom edge and corners
 of the glass prior to and during installation.
- This unit must be installed upon a finished threshold and against finished walls.
- DreamLine® shower doors are not designed to be installed into a fiberglass surround due to the radius corners and lack of a solid surface to mount the hardware.

WARNING: TO AVOID THE RISK OF DAMAGE OR INJURY:

- Follow all recommendations and requirements as shown in the installation instructions.
- Perform a thorough inspection of the glass and all parts for any damage prior to installation. Any damage to tempered glass can cause breakage.

Do Not install damaged glass!

- Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered
 edges or is otherwise damaged. Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door that has
 been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as tile, marble or glass.
- CAUTION: Contact with any hard surface can damage tempered glass and cause it to shatter.
- This product uses tempered glass. Glass cannot be cut after it has been tempered.
 Do Not attempt to cut tempered glass.
- DreamLine[®] Glass Shower doors, Tub doors, Inline panels, and Return panels can shatter
 due to improper handling or lack of maintenance. Conduct periodic inspections of glass
 and all parts for possible damage, missing or loose parts.
- Always wear proper safety equipment such as: safety goggles, work gloves and appropriate footwear during the installation process.
- WARNING. Risk of leakage and/or damage. Follow all instructions regarding the
 application of silicone sealant or caulk. Allow 24 hours for the sealant to cure before the
 initial use of the shower or tub product. Follow the silicone manufacturer's
 recommendations regarding the use of their product.
- Thoroughly read these instructions before installing or using this product.
- Leave this manual for the end-user of the product.



This product should be installed by someone familiar with the construction requirements for this type of project and the care necessary for the safe installation and operation of the product.


<u>DO NOT</u> attach the handle to the door glass until instructed. **<u>DO NOT</u>** attempt to use the handle to lift the door glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious injury.

Always use a professional grade glass suction cup and an assistant.

Verify that the correct model size has been ordered; measure the finished opening **before** proceeding with the installation.


Confirm that the finished walls are plumb and the threshold is level and pitched into the shower area.

Use a good quality waterproof, mildew-resistant 100% silicone caulk.

Cover the shower/tub drain with tape prior to installation to prevent the loss of screws or small parts.



Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay it out and identify all parts using the **Detailed Diagram** on page 5; and packing list in this manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that may have fallen to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine® for replacement. The shipping boxes may contain extra parts not used in your model configuration. Retain these installation instructions for future reference.










Installation Steps



Check the finished shower opening to make sure the threshold is level and pitched slightly inward, and the walls are no more than 3/8" out-of-plumb. Be sure to have at least 2-3/4"" of threshold and wall space for installation. **Fig 1**
















Measure across the top, middle and bottom of the finished shower opening (from wall to wall) and record the measurements. The top measurement should be taken at the height of the model and will be used for cutting the **Top Guide Rail (#06)** (if necessary). **Fig 1a**



For a successful installation, the walls cannot be out-of-plumb by more than 3/8". If the out-of-plumb condition exceeds 3/8", the door cannot be successfully installed.









Use this cutting formula for the **Top Guide Rail (#06)**:


Model Size - Finished Opening Width = Cut-off Length

For Example Only:

60" Model Width
- 58" Finished Opening
2" Cutoff Length

Or:


60" Model Width
- 58-1/4" Finished Opening
1-3/4" Cutoff Length





Cut the **Top Guide Rail (#06)** from the **Small Inline Panel Glass** end <u>only</u> (the end without the stickers). The maximum cutoff amount is 2". Do not exceed the maximum cutoff length. **Fig 4**






Measure in at least **1-1/4**" from the outside threshold edge and mark an even line across the threshold. Use a 4' or 6' level to extend a plumb line up both walls. This will mark the outside edge position of the **U-Channels** to be installed in the next few steps. Another **1-1/2**" of flat threshold space is needed beyond the line for successful installation of this shower door. **Fig 5**







Use the drilling instructions below to drill holes in the threshold for both **Bottom U-Channels**. Apply silicone to the underside of both **U-Channels** as well as in the screw holes and install the **U-Channels** using the three **ST4.2x35mm Countersunk Screws (#20)**. **Fig 7**












- If a stud is present behind the threshold: drill a Ø3/16"(4mm) hole to the stud, drill an Ø1/8"(3mm) pilot hole into the stud.
- If no stud is present behind the threshold: drill a Ø5/16"(7mm) hole and insert the Wall Anchors (#07).
- For installation into Acrylic, drill a Ø1/8"(3mm) hole.








Place both **Vertical U-Channels (#03 and #04)** on the marks made on the walls and evenly on top of the **Bottom U-Channels**. Check them for plumb with a level. The shorter **Vertical U-Channel for Small Stationary Panel (#03)** will go on the strike side of the shower door. Mark the holes for drilling through the holes in both **U-Channels**. **Fig 8**





Drill holes for both Vertical U-Channels (#03 and #04) at the marks just made (See drilling instructions below). Apply silicone to the backs of the **U-Channels** and in the screw holes. Install the Vertical U-Channels using the ST 4.2x40mm Countersunk Screws (#21). Fig 9





- an Ø1/8"(3mm) pilot hole into the stud.
- If no stud is present behind the wall: drill a Ø5/16" (7mm) hole and insert the Wall Anchors (#07).
- For installation into Acrylic, drill a Ø1/8"(3mm) hole.





Fig 11a 3 Use a Speed Square to keep the brackets plumb during installation. **Parts Needed Tools Needed** Fig 11b

Use tape to keep the two Stationary Glass Panels from moving while the silicone sets up. The use of a fast-setting silicone is recommended. **Fig 11a**



Install the **Small Inline Panel Bracket (#08)** on the **Small Inline Panel Glass (#25).** Install both **Large Inline Panel Brackets (#09)** onto the **Large Inline Panel Glass (#24)**. Use a speed square to plumb the brackets as they are installed. **Fig 11b**








Install the 2nd Guide Rail Bracket (#12) on the right end of the Top Guide Rail (#06). Loosen the set screws in the installed Guide Rail Bracket, then place the left side of the Top Guide Rail in the installed Guide Rail Bracket. Level the Guide Rail across the opening. Place the outside edge of the right Guide Rail Bracket 1" forward of the line from Step 5 and the bottom edge 76-5/8" above the threshold. Have a helper hold the Guide Rail while marking the bracket location and the holes for drilling. Set the Top Guide Rail and right Guide Rail Bracket aside. Fig 14





Loosen and move the Inline Panel Brackets if needed to make installation of the **Guide** Rail Brackets easier.



















Use a speed square to check the **Small and Large Panel Brackets** (#08, 09) for plumb. Mark the position of the top of the **Inline Panel Brackets** on the bottom of the **Top Guide Rail**, using the stickers on the bottom of the **Top Guide Rail** (#06) as general guides only. **Fig 16**





Lower the **Top Guide Rail (#06)** onto the **Inline Panel Brackets (#08,#09)**. Tighten the set screws at the top of the **Inline Panel Brackets**. Slide the **Guide Rail Brackets (#12)** back over the Guide Rail Bracket Blocks on the walls and tighten the top and bottom set screws. **Fig 18**









The **Top Guide Rail (#06)** can be adjusted slightly (to bring it to level if needed) by adjusting the **Guide Rail Brackets**. Turning the top and bottom inside set screws will raise or lower the **Guide Rail Bracket** sleeve and the **Top Guide Rail** as well. **Fig 19**












Place the **Guide Block (#11)** against the **Bottom U-Channel for Stationary Panel (#01)** on the threshold as pictured below, square and centered on the **U-Channel**, the roller on the inside of the shower. Mark the hole for drilling. Follow the drilling instructions below. Drill a hole in the threshold and install the **Guide Block (#11)**. **Fig 21**







Parts Needed







If a stud is present behind the threshold:
 drill a Ø3/16"(4mm) hole to the stud, drill an Ø1/8"(3mm) pilot hole into the stud and use the included screw.

OR

• If no stud is present behind the threshold (i.e. Composite threshold): Drill a Ø5/16"(7mm) hole and insert a Wall Anchor (#22) and use the included screw.







Use a helper to lift and guide the **Door Glass**, angling the **Roller Assemblies** to fit into the track in the **Top Guide Rail**. Move the **Door Glass** to the **Small Inline Panel** side, then carefully bring the **Bottom Guide** over the roller on the **Guide Block**. Check that the **Door Glass** travels smoothly in the **Top Guide Rail** and that the **Guide Channel (#07)** on the bottom of the **Door Glass (#23)** is only touching the roller on the **Bottom Guide Block (#11)**. **Fig 22**
















Close the **Door Glass** so it overlaps both side panels, leaving 2-3" between the **Small Inline Panel Glass (#25)** and the **Handle (#14)**, allowing room to grasp the handle. Place a **Stopper (#13)** in the **Top Guide Rail**, adjacent to the outside of the **Roller Assembly** above the **Handle**, and mark the hole for drilling. Open the **Door Glass**, leaving 2-3" between the **Handle** and the **Large Inline Panel Glass (#24)**. Place the **Stopper (#13)** on the outside of the other **Roller Assembly**, and mark the hole for drilling. **Fig 24**













Install one of the Vertical Vinyl Seals for Stationary Panels (#17) on the Large Inline Panel Glass (#24) with the soft fin facing inward. Measure the edge of the Small Inline Panel Glass (#25) and cut the remaining Vertical Vinyl Seal to that length. Install the remaining Vertical Vinyl Seal. Fig 28



Apply a good-quality, mildew-resistant silicone to the entire interior perimeter of the shower door. Allow **24 hours** for the silicone to fully cure before using the shower. **Fig 28**





Product Maintenance

BASES and BACKWALLS: To ensure long lasting life for your acrylic back walls: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could permanently scratch or dull the surface.

<u>GLASS</u>: To ensure long lasting life for your glass shower products: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface of the glass.

HARDWARE: To ensure a long lasting finish: wipe off all metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft clean-cloth. Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with the grain (not across the grain). Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.



To maximize the life of your door, it is important to regularly inspect the glass and other hardware for misalignment, proper attachment, and/or damage. Contact DreamLine® with any questions or concerns.

Water Leakage	 Confirm the Threshold Dam Strip (#05), VHB Threshold Seal (#16), and the Vertical Vinyl Seals (#17) are installed correctly. Confirm that the entire unit has been properly sealed with silicone caulk; allow at least 24 hours to allow the silicone to cure and set before using the shower unit. Confirm the Guide Channel (#07) on the Door Glass (#23) is installed correctly and is making contact with the roller only on the Bottom Guide Block (#11). Confirm the Guide Channel (#07) on the Door Glass (#23) is installed correctly and is only making contact with the roller on the Bottom Guide Block (#11). Be sure there is nothing in the Top Guide Rail (#06) (such as debris) that could block the Roller Wheel Assemblies (#10).

•Always take precautions when handling tempered glass. •A glass suction cup and an assistant are helpful when carrying large, heavy lites of glass. •Never allow tempered glass (especially the edges) to come in contact with any hard surface. Such contact can cause chipping, splintering or complete glass failure. •Any damaged glass should be replaced immediately. •Do not use a shower with damaged glass. •Leave the plastic corner protectors on the glass until ready to install. •Always protect the glass once removed from the box by padding the top and bottom of the glass with cardboard, Styrofoam or other soft material until ready to install.




