# Safety Precautions

## IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

### READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING

#### Symbols and Meanings

##### **WARNING**

May result in death or serious injury.

##### **CAUTION**

May result in injury or property damage.

##### **WARNING**

#### Never disassemble, repair or alter.

Doing so may cause fire, electrical shock, overheating, short circuit or breakdown.

#### Do not use the product if a malfunction occurs.

In case of breakdown or other problem, be sure to cut off power by means such as unplugging the power plug.

Close the water shutoff valve to stop water supply.

Possible malfunctions:

- Water is leaking from a pipe or the main unit.
- The product is cracked or broken.
- The product makes a strange noise or emits a strange odor.
- The product emits smoke.
- The product is abnormally hot.
- The toilet seat cushion is out of place.

Continued use after malfunction could cause a fire, electrical shock, heat, short circuit, injury or water damage.

#### Do not use other water than allowed by the laws and ordinances of the region of use. Only Use potable water.

#### Do not use seawater or recycled water.

Doing so may cause irritation to the skin and malfunction.

#### Keep cigarettes and other open flames away from the product.

Failure to do so may cause fire.

##### **WARNING**

**Do not stick a finger or anything else into the warm air outlet.**

**Do not place anything on the warm air outlet or drape clothes over it.**

Doing so may cause burns, electrical shock or malfunction.

**Do not install the product on moving vehicles such as wheeled vehicles or boats.**

Doing so may cause fire, electric shock, short circuit or malfunction.

The toilet seat, toilet lid, main unit, or other parts may come loose and fall off, resulting in injury.

**Do not use any power supply other than the one specified.**

AC 120 V, 60 Hz

Doing so may cause fire or excessive heat.

**This is an electrical product. Do not install it anywhere water is likely to get on the product or anywhere with humidity high enough that water is likely to form on the surface of this product. When using the product in a bathroom, install a fan or ventilation port and ensure good air flow through the bathroom.**

Failure to do so may cause fire or electrical shock.

**Always connect the product to the cold water supply.**

## ⚠ CAUTION

**Do not use the product if the main unit is unstable.**

Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

**If the product is damaged, do not touch the damaged section.**

Doing so may cause electrical shock or injury.

Replace it immediately.

**Do not apply strong force, mechanical shock, step on or stand on the toilet seat, toilet lid or main unit. Also do not place any heavy object on the toilet seat, toilet lid or main unit.**

Doing so may cause cracking or cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

Doing so may damage the product and cause injury or water damage.

**Do not lift up this product by the toilet seat or lid.**

**Do not raise the toilet seat or lid while objects are resting on top of the unit.**

Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

**When maintaining the plastic parts (main unit etc.) or the water supply hose, use a pH neutral kitchen detergent diluted with water. Do not use any of the following.**

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Doing so will cause water to spurt out.

Frozen water pipes could cause the main unit and the pipes to break, resulting in a water leak.

Regulate the room temperature to prevent the pipes and hoses from freezing during cold months.

Drain the water.

**When not using the product for a long time, close the shutoff valve, drain the water from the main unit and water supply hose, and then turn the power OFF.\*1**

When using the product again, allow the product to refill with water first. Otherwise, the water in the tank might become contaminated and cause skin inflammation or other problems. (→Refer to Page 44 for instructions on replenishing the water.)

Leaving the power on may cause fire or heat.

**When installing the drain plug with water supply filter, make sure that it is securely tightened in its proper position.**

Failure to securely tighten it may cause a water leak.

**If the bowl is clogged, turn the power OFF\*1 and remove the clog.**

Use commercially available tools that are made for unclogging the bowl unit to remove the clogging.

**Push the main unit securely on to the base plate.**

After pushing the main unit until a click sound is heard, pull it slightly toward you to make sure that the product does not detach.

Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

**Make sure of the plus and minus signs on the batteries before inserting them.**

**Remove depleted batteries immediately.**

**When replacing the batteries:**

- Replace both batteries with new ones.
- Use the same brand for both new batteries (any brand available).

Failure to do so may cause the batteries to leak fluid, generate heat, rupture, or ignite.

**When the product is supposed not to be used for long time, remove the batteries from the remote control.**

Failure to do so may cause the batteries to leak fluid.

# Grounding Instructions

This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electrical current.

This product is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug.

The plug must be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded.

**DANGER** - Improper use of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock.

If repair or replacement of the cord or plug is necessary, do not connect the grounding wire to either flat-head terminal.

Check with a qualified electrician or service-man if the grounding wire instructions are not completely understood, or if in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded.


# Operational Precautions

### For prevention of malfunctions

Do not block the remote control transmitter or receiver.

#### About the seat switch

When you sit on the toilet seat, the seat switch turns ON, enabling you to use various features. (A click sound is heard when the seat switch is ACTIVATED.)



#### Sit back on the toilet seat.

The seat switch will not turn on unless you sit on the seat properly.




**Note:** When a child uses the product, the seat switch may not be ACTIVATED by their light body weight. Since the toilet seat is designed to move up and down, a clearance is provided between the toilet seat cushion and the bowl unit.

# Operational Precautions

## For prevention of damage

**Wipe plastic areas such as the main unit and remote control with a soft cloth tightly wrung out with water.**



Dry cloth or tissue

**Do not lean against the toilet lid.**



## For prevention of malfunctions and failures

**Turn the power OFF if there is a risk for lightning strike.\*1**

**A toilet seat cover or a toilet lid cover cannot be used.**

Otherwise, the seat switch may not detect properly. Additionally, the toilet seat and lid may not open or close properly.



**Do not urinate on the main unit, toilet seat or wand.**  
Doing so may cause a failure or discoloration.

**Do not apply strong forces to the control panel of the remote control.**

**When using a toilet cleaner to clean the toilet, rinse it off within 3 minutes and leave the toilet seat and toilet lid open.**

If vapor from a toilet cleaner enters the main unit, it may cause a malfunction.  
► Wipe off any cleaner that remains on the bowl unit.

**Do not use the product with the toilet lid removed.**

## Do not expose to direct sunlight.

Doing so may cause changes in color, irregular heated seat temperature or remote control malfunction. It may also cause product malfunction due to the change in temperature.

## Use radios, etc. away from the product.

The product could cause interference with the radio signal.

## If you use a booster seat for infants or a soft highchair, remove it after use.

Keeping it installed may prevent some of the functions from being used.

## Do not apply force to the remote control.

This cause malfunction.

► To prevent the remote control from being dropped, set it in the hanger when you are not using it.



Be careful not to expose it to water.

## Do not place anything on the toilet seat and lid, and do not press them with hands.

Doing so may activate the seat switch, causing the floor to get wet if buttons on the remote control are touched and warm water comes out from the wand.




**B: Front side of the main unit**

**D: Right side of the main unit**




# Preparation

## Using the Product for the First Time


### 1. Insert the battery

#### 1.1 Remove the remote control from the hanger.



#### 1.2 Open the battery cover and insert two AAA batteries.

After inserting batteries, close the battery cover.



► When batteries are properly loaded, all the LEDs on the remote control light up for about 2 sec.

#### 1.3 Mount the remote control in the hanger.

### About the batteries

#### Use dry cell, alkaline batteries.


Be sure to follow "Safety Precautions" to prevent the batteries from rupturing or leaking fluid. (→Pages 4, 7)

### 2. Turn on the power

#### 2.1 Insert the power plug.

► The wand extends and then retracts.

#### 2.2 Check the "Power" LED illuminates.



#### If the light is off

Switch "Power" to "ON" using the remote control.

► Press "Power ON/OFF" button about 3 seconds or longer.


#### To turn the power "OFF"

Unplug the power plug.

► The "Power" LED is unilluminated.

### 3. Open the shutoff valve

#### 3.1 Fully open the shutoff valve.



# Basic Operations

## Mechanism of Auto Functions

"EWATER+" is used automatically to clean the wand.

### 1. As you sit<sup>\*1</sup>



Deodorizer  
Pre-mist

#### Deodorizer



Removing odors inside the bowl unit.

**Note:** Deodorizing filter needs regular maintenance.  
(→Page 38)

#### Pre-mist



A mist is automatically sprayed inside the bowl unit to make it more difficult for dirt to adhere.

### 2. As you stand up



Auto power deodorizer  
Auto wand CLEAN

#### Auto power deodorizer

After about 10 seconds

#### Starts the auto power deodorizer



It stops about 60 seconds after you stand up from the toilet seat

#### Auto wand CLEAN

**Only when the washing functions are used.**

After about 25 seconds

#### The wand extends to clean with the "EWATER+" that comes out of the base<sup>\*2</sup>



**Note:** "EWATER+" can also be used by pressing the remote control button. (→Page 19 "Wand CLEAN")



#### What is meant by "EWATER+?"

"EWATER+" helps the self-cleaning wand feature work effectively and by preventing the accumulation of dirt that can cause stains.

- "EWATER+" is generated from chemicals already present in potable water.
- "EWATER+" helps to minimize dirty surfaces, but does not make cleaning unnecessary.
- The effect of rinsing with "EWATER+" can vary depending on the frequency of toilet use and other conditions.




#### A Soft light

Lighting up the inside of the bathroom with a soft light.

**Note:** "Soft light" can be switched between ON, OFF and TIMER. (→Page 31)

#### B Wand CLEAN LED

##### During Wand CLEAN




Flashing

\*1 Water comes out from the area around the wand for several seconds while water is warmed up.

\*2 When the washing functions (Rear washing and Front washing etc.) have not been used in 8 hours, the wand is cleaned automatically. (Water comes out from around the wand.)

# Basic Operations

## Using the Remote Control



Operate the controls on the remote control; a beep sounds when the main unit receives the signal.

**A** ■ **Stop**  
Stops the B, C or D operation.

**B** **Rear washing**  
Washes your rear.  
**Rear soft washing**  
 Washes your rear with mild water pressure.

The setting changes between and each time the is pressed.

**C** **Front washing**  
Serves as a bidet for ladies.

**D** **Warm air drying**  
Dries your rear.

**E** — + **Water pressure adjustment**  
You can adjust the water pressure to one of five levels. [-] Softer, [+] Stronger  
After you press the "Water pressure adjustment" button, the set position will light for 10 seconds.

**F** ▲ ▼ **Wand position adjustment**  
You can adjust the washing position to 5 different points between the front and the rear, using the [▲] and [▼] buttons.

Once use of the remote control is finished, the settings will return to the initial setting (3rd position) after a while, not exceeding a maximum of 5 minutes.

If you do not want to return to 3rd position.  
(→Page 32)

**Note:** Sitting back on the toilet seat makes it easier to adjust the wand position and to reduce splashing.

**G** **Pulsating washing**  
Washes with the water pressure pulsating between soft and strong.

**H** **Oscillating washing**  
The wand moves back and forth to washes your rear thoroughly.

**Note:** Sitting back on the toilet seat makes it easier to adjust the wand position and to reduce splashing.

**I** **Wand CLEAN**  
Cleans the wand with "EWATER+"<sup>3</sup>

After wand cleaning, water comes out from around the wand.

**Note:** This function will operate automatically after using the washing functions (Rear washing, Front washing, etc.). (→Pages 16, 29 "Auto wand CLEAN")

**Note:** To clean the wand with it extended.  
(→Page 38 "Wand cleaning")

**J** **Personal setting**  
Up to four people can register their preferred "Water pressure", "Wand position" and "Warm water temperature" settings. (→Page 33)




# Temperature Adjustment

## Warm Water, Toilet Seat, Drying

Three different temperature levels from high to low and "OFF" can be set.

### Remote control back side

How to remove the remote control (→Page 14)



- A Warm water temperature button  
(When you want to adjust the warm water temperature)
- B Toilet seat temperature button  
(When you want to adjust the toilet seat temperature)
- C Drying air temperature button  
(When you want to adjust the drying air temperature)
- D Displaying the temperature level of the pressed button

## Adjusting the temperature

1. Remove the remote control from the hanger.  
(→Page 14)
2. Choose and press the button of the temperature that you want to set from the ("Toilet seat temperature" button), ("Warm water temperature" button) and (Drying air temperature button).  
► The current temperature level appears.

### Settings complete

- When seat temperature is set, the SEAT LED illuminates.




**Note:** The "Drying" cannot be turned "OFF".  
If the button is not pressed for about 10 seconds, the "Temperature adjustment" LED will go off, but the setting will be retained.  
If the "Temperature adjustment" LED goes out before the setting is completed, start all over again at step 2.

4. Mount the remote control in the hanger.  
(→Page 14)

If adjusting the temperature does not warm up the toilet seat.

► Is the energy saver set to "ON"? (→Pages 26, 27)


3. Press the button selected in step 2 repeatedly until a desired temperature level illuminates.  
► The setting changes each time the button is pressed once



## To turn the warm water temperature\*1 and toilet seat temperature "OFF"

1. Remove the remote control from the hanger.

2. Select a temperature button you want to turn "OFF" from ("Toilet seat temperature" button), ("Warm water temperature" button) and press it.  
► The current temperature level appears.

3. Press the button selected in step 2 repeatedly until the temperature level is set to "OFF".  
► The setting changes each time the button is pressed once



### Settings complete

- When seat temperature is OFF, the SEAT LED is unilluminated.



**Note:** The "Drying" cannot be turned "OFF".

4. Mount the remote control in the hanger.

\*1 To prevent condensation, the water temperature does not drop below 68 °F (20 °C) even when set to "OFF".

# Changing Settings

## The energy saver features

"Auto energy saver" and "Timer energy saver" can be selected. To save energy, the temperature of the toilet seat becomes low (or "OFF").

**Note:** Even if the energy saver is activated (with the toilet seat heater set to Low or OFF), the toilet seat will be temporarily heated when you sit on it. (To reach the set temperature, the toilet seat takes about 15 minutes.) The LED indication on the main display returns to the state for when the energy saver is on.



## Auto energy saver


You want the product to save energy automatically

The product detects time periods with infrequent use and lowers the toilet seat temperature automatically.

It takes about 10 days for the product to determine the periods when it is used relatively less frequently.

### When energy saver is in operation

#### Main display



#### Toilet seat heater




## Timer energy saver

You want to save energy only for a preset duration of time. (6 hours, 9 hours)

Once the time is set, the toilet seat heater turns off automatically during the set time period every day.

# Maintenance

## Before Maintenance

### **WARNING**

Always turn off the power before maintenance or inspection.  
Failure to do so may cause electric shock or malfunction, resulting in a breakdown.

## For safety, turn the power OFF before maintenance.\*<sup>1</sup>

When the power is turned OFF, the Power LED is unilluminated.



### To turn the power "OFF"

Unplug the power plug.

### To turn the power "ON"

Insert the power plug.

### Attention

This product is an electric appliance. Be careful not to let water seep inside or leave detergent in the gap between the main unit and bowl unit.  
Do not put any cleaning solution directly onto the warm air outlet or cover around the wand, etc.  
May damage plastic parts or cause a malfunction.

When using a toilet cleaner to clean the toilet, rinse it off within 3 minutes and leave the toilet seat and toilet lid open.

Wipe off any cleaner that remains on the bowl unit.  
If vapor from a toilet cleaner enters the main unit, it may cause a malfunction.

**Do not press or pull the warm air outlet or cover around the wand with excessive force.**  
Doing so may cause damage or failure.

**Wipe the back surface of the toilet seat and the toilet seat cushions with a soft cloth tightly wrung out with water.**  
Otherwise adhesion of dirt may result in discoloration.



## Gap between the Main Unit and Bowl Unit

You can remove the main unit to clean the top of the bowl unit and the bottom of the main unit.





Align the main unit with the center of the base plate and press it firmly onto the base plate until a click sound is heard.

#### Attention

**Be careful not to pinch the power cord.**

**Do not excessively bend the water supply hose.**

### CAUTION

**Push the main unit firmly on to the base plate until a click sound is heard.**

Doing so may cause the main unit to come loose and fall, resulting in injury.

- After mounting, check that the main unit does not detach even when pulled.

# What to Do?

## If the water does not flow due to a water service interruption

Make sure to also check the instruction manual of your bowl unit.

### 1. Use a bucket to flush the bowl unit.



### 2. If the water level is low after flushing, add more water. (Until the water level does not rise further.)

▶ Prevents odors.

#### Attention

When the water supply is restored, make sure to first use water in the bath or kitchen (not with this product) to remove air from the water supply pipes.


Otherwise, air or foreign objects may enter this product, causing failure.

**After that, be sure to perform a full flush.**

To prevent waste from remaining in the drain pipe.


## If you cannot operate with the remote control

If the low battery warning mark "■" on the surface of the remote control is flashing, please replace the batteries.



## Replacing the batteries

3. Open the battery cover and replace with two new AAA batteries. ([Page 14](#))
  - ▶ The low battery warning mark is unilluminated.

  - ▶ The "Power" LED illuminates.



#### Attention

"ON" and "OFF" settings of the functions such as the energy saver function may be canceled when the batteries are replaced.  
Set them again.

## Freeze Damage Prevention

When the ambient temperature is likely to drop to 32 °F (0 °C) or lower, take measures to prevent freezing.

#### Attention

When the ambient temperature is likely to drop to 32 °F (0 °C) or lower, do not use the energy saver feature. Otherwise, the product may break down.

Warm the bathroom or take measures against freezing so that the ambient temperature does not drop below 32 °F (0 °C).







## Long Periods of Disuse

If the toilet is in a location you will not visit for a long time, drain the water.

Water inside the product may become contaminated and cause skin irritation or other problems. (The water may freeze, causing damage to the product.)

**When there is a risk of freezing, take measures to prevent freezing. (*→Pages 41, 42*)**

Otherwise, the product may break down.

# Troubleshooting

- A:** Is the Power LED illuminated?

#### Is the breaker on the distribution board turned on?

- Check whether there is a power outage or the breaker has turned "OFF".

#### Is the "Power ON/OFF" setting "OFF"?

- Switch it to "ON" with the remote control. (→Page 14 Step 2-2.2)

#### Is the "Power" LED on the main display flashing?

- The main unit is not mounted properly.  
Mount them correctly again. (→Page 36)


- B:** Is the Energy saver LED lit?

- While the LED is lit, energy saver (→Pages 26, 27) is in operation, so the toilet seat temperature may be reduced or the heater may be turned off.

- C:** Is the remote control working?


Is the low battery warning mark on the surface of the remote control flashing?

- Replace the batteries. (→Pages 14, 40)



#### Is the remote control transmitter or the remote control receiver blocked?

- Remove obstructions, dirt, water droplets or any other blockages.



# Troubleshooting

## Rear Washing, Front Washing and Wand

<b>The wand (or washing water) does not come out</b>	<p>When the temperature is low, it takes time for the wand to come out after the remote control button is pressed because the water must be warmed up first.</p> <p>Has the toilet been sat "ON" and used continuously for 2 hours or longer? (If so, operation is stopped for safety purposes.)</p> <p>► Stand up from the seat and then use again.</p> <p>If the water supply pressure drops significantly, for example if water is used elsewhere or if there is a water failure, the function may stop for safety.</p> <p>► Turn the power OFF and wait about 10 seconds before turning the power ON again. The auto power deodorizer feature is not working	<p>Is "Auto power deodorizer" set to "OFF"? ► Set to "ON". (<i>→Page 30</i>)</p> <p>The auto power deodorizer starts about 10 seconds after you stand up from the toilet seat.</p>

The soft light does not light up	<p>Is "Soft light" turned OFF? ► Set to "ON". (<i>→Page 31</i>)</p>
The soft light lights permanently	<p>Is "Soft light" turned ON? ► If it is turned ON, the Soft light lights permanently. You can turn it "OFF". (<i>→Page 31</i>)</p>

## Others

## One Year Limited Warranty

1. TOTO warrants its product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship during normal use when properly installed and serviced, for a period of one (1) year from date of purchase. This limited warranty is extended only to the ORIGINAL PURCHASER of the Product and is not transferable to any third party, including but not limited to any subsequent purchaser or owner of the Product. This warranty applies only to TOTO Product is purchased and installed in USA and Canada.
2. TOTO's obligations under this warranty are limited to repair, replacement or other appropriate adjustment, at TOTO's option, of the Product or parts found to be defective in normal use, provided that such Product was properly installed, used and serviced in accordance with instructions. TOTO reserves the right to make such inspections as may be necessary in order to determine the cause of the defect. TOTO will not charge for labor or parts in connection with warranty repairs or replacements. TOTO is not responsible for the cost of removal, return and/or reinstallation of the Product.
3. This warranty does not apply to the following items:
  - a) Damage or loss sustained in a natural calamity such as fire, earthquake, flood, thunder, electrical storm, etc.
  - b) Damage or loss resulting from any accident, unreasonable use, misuse, abuse, negligence, improper care, or maintenance of the Product.
  - c) Damage or loss resulting from sediments or foreign matter contained in a water system.
  - d) Damage or loss resulting from the quality of water in the region where the product is used.
